Introduction

On this voyage, you will sail the Antarctic Peninsula, also known as the White Continent. Prior to the trip, spend one night in Buenos Aires, often known as the 'Paris of the south'. Fly to Ushuaia, also referred to as the 'End of the world', where your adventure will begin. Board the 264-passenger Seabourn Pursuit, an opulent expedition ship and settle into your cabin. Enjoy amenities like a fitness centre, spa, sauna, and outdoor pool and a selection of high-quality restaurants and bars, while cruising in style. There are numerous luxurious suites available for selection on board. Each and every suite has a balcony and in-room dining and mini-bar are included in your cruise fare.

After arriving in Antarctica, you will spend your time on the Peninsula taking part in a variety of excursions and activities including landings, hiking and zodiac rides, all under the guidance of the knowledgeable expedition crew. Explore pack ice and keep a lookout for fur seals, whales and penguins. Additional adventure activities including kayaking and submarine excursions are available on some departures at an additional cost.

Earth, outperforming New York, London

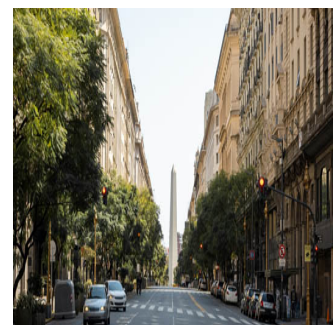
and Paris. Every weekend, over 300

DAY 2: Fly to Ushuaia & Embarkation

Start your day by flying from Buenos Aires

to Ushuaia. Upon landing, our team will be

ready to pick you up at the airport and

ensure a seamless transfer to the ship for

embarkation. Once deemed too harsh for

European settlement, Ushuaia's rugged

beauty was the realm of its native

inhabitants - the Yahgan People. Today, it

holds the distinctive title of being the

southernmost city on Earth, often referred

to as 'the end of the world.' Situated along

the banks of the Beagle Channel, Ushuaia

unveils itself like an artist's masterpiece. A

mosaic of vibrant houses adds a splash of

color against the dramatic backdrop of

snow-capped mountains. Dominating this

breathtaking panorama is Monte Olivia, its

jagged peaks soaring 4,530 feet above the

landscape.
