This exclusive cruise is aboard the modern polar expedition vessel, Douglas Mawson (built in 2025), the latest addition to the fleet. With a capacity of just 130 guests, this environmentally-friendly ship offers a more comfortable and intimate experience compared to larger, older vessels. It features the innovative Ulstein X-BOW to reduce fuel consumption and provide a smoother ride.

Perfect for couples, friends, and solo adventurers, this expedition offers a balance of wildlife encounters, offboard activities, and onboard scientific talks. The flexible itinerary ensures the best opportunities for exploring and learning, as the captain and expedition leader adjust plans based on conditions and sightings.

DAY 1: Ushuaia

Upon arrival in Ushuaia, you will be transferred to your pre-voyage hotel. If you're already in Ushuaia, please make your own way to the hotel. Check-in will start in the afternoon and the team will provide details about embarkation, answer questions, and offer information about dining options and last-minute shopping. The rest of the day is free for you to enjoy.

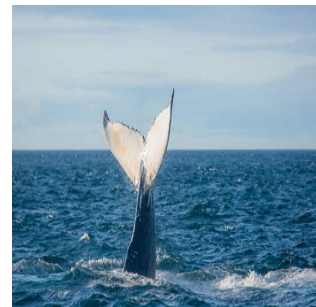
Embarkation

After breakfast on the Peninsula you can spend the day at leisure and then meet at the hotel lobby or designated parking lot to be transferred to the pier for embarkation. Once onboard, settle into your cabin before attending mandatory briefings. As the ship departs, join fellow expeditioners on deck to enjoy stunning views of Ushuaia and Tierra del Fuego. The evening includes a welcome dinner to kick off the exciting Antarctic adventure.



DAY 3: Drake Passage Crossing Days 3-4

Explore the onboard gym, wellness center, and well-stocked library. Your expedition team will present various talks on Antarctica's history, wildlife, and environment to enhance your journey. You'll also be invited attend important briefings on biosecurity, wildlife-watching guidelines, and Zodiac safety to prepare for your first landing in Antarctica. On day four, excitement builds as you approach the South Shetland Islands and the Antarctic Peninsula. Everyone will gather on the observation decks to catch their first glimpse of an iceberg. Now south of the Antarctic Convergence, the ocean takes on a new character, surrounded by penguins and towering icebergs. The memory of spotting your first iceberg will likely stay with you forever.

12 Days in Antarctica is an indescribable

experience — Spotting your first iceberg

and reaching Antarctica's Peninsula

will have a lasting impression. Once we arrive,

the western Antarctic Peninsula and South

Shetland Islands offer many exciting

exploration opportunities. With 18-24 hours

of daylight, you can choose how active or

relaxed you want your days to be. Your

expert expedition team, with extensive

experience in the region, will tailor your

voyage based on weather, ice conditions,

and wildlife sightings. Activities include

Zodiac safaris to explore coves, glaciers,

and wildlife, and guided hikes on pristine

beaches. Bundle up for Zodiac cruises

through ice cliffs and grounded icebergs,

watching for whales, seals, and penguins.

Zodiacs will also transport you to land for

visits to penguin rookeries, historic huts,

and scenic spots along the peninsula. On

shore, you'll have the chance to explore

beaches, hike snow-covered ridgelines, and

take in panoramic mountain and ocean

views. In addition to Zodiac excursions, we

may cruise through dramatic straits or

scenic bays to observe whales and other

wildlife. The observation lounge and bridge

offer stunning views of Antarctica's beauty.

You may even hear the rumble of glaciers

carving into the sea, creating a moment of

awe in this pristine landscape. Educational

presentations on polar science, wildlife,

history, photography, and more will be held

throughout the voyage. These lectures aim

to engage and educate while deepening

your connection to the planet. Your

expedition crew will provide commentary

and introductions to the phenomena you'll

encounter. You can also participate in a

citizen science program, helping collect

valuable data to support global research. A

citizen science coordinator will assist with

projects that contribute to protecting the

planet. For a deeper understanding, visit

the Citizen Science Centre, which offers one

of the best views on the ship. Overall, the

expedition is flexible, allowing you to choose

your level of involvement with activities,

talks, and excursions—none of which are

mandatory.
