fabled journey while catching glimpses of

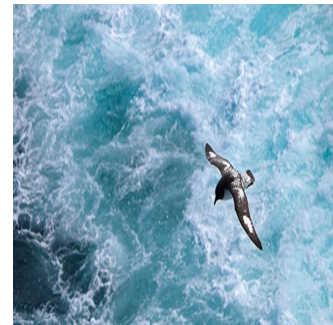
rarely seen wildlife. Keep your binoculars

take full advantage of every opportunity to

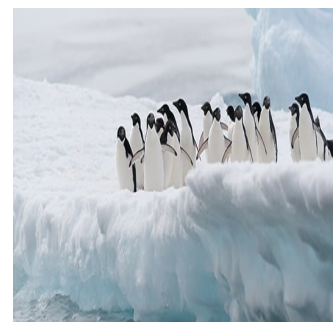
visit some of the several active scientific

Gentoo penguins, and it's not uncommon to

share the water's edge with Elephant and

Fur seals. Whales are often spotted as well.

So, we'll settle into our Zodiacs and spend

most of our day exploring. And kayakers, it's

time to get your first taste of gliding just

inches off the pristine Antarctic water.

Whether on land or sea, in Zodiac or kayak,

be prepared for a fully immersive

introduction to this incomparable part of the

world.



DAY 9: Drake Passage - Day 9 & 10

We leave this magical place and make our

way north, once again heading across the

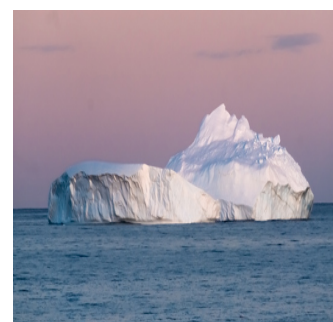
Antarctic Convergence and the Drake

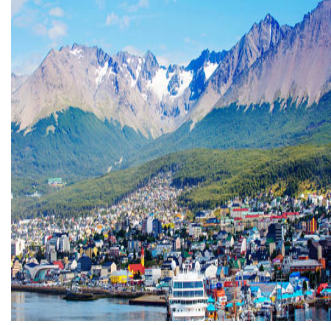
